Curriculum vitae of Ewald A. Werner

Ewald A. Werner was born in Austria in 1956. He graduated from Kennett High School (PA, USA) in 1973 and from Leoben High School in 1974.

After military service he entered the University of Leoben (Montanuniversität) in 1975 where he majored in materials science. He graduated in 1980 and earned his doctorate degree in 1984 with a thesis on plasticity of multiphase materials. After two years as post-doc at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) Zürich he worked for the Austrian Academy of Sciences in the field of metal physics. He completed his habilitation in metal physics in 1991 and was appointed assistant professor (1991) and associate professor (1996) at the University of Leoben. In 1997 Werner was appointed full professor of mechanics and head of the State Material Testing Laboratory (MPA) at the Technische Universität München. Werner conducts research on the processing — microstructure — properties — relationships of metallic materials using experimental, analytical and numerical techniques. He is author of over 250 scientific papers and co-authored 5 text books on materials science, materials technology and mechanics. Since 1999 he serves as editor of the Elsevier journal Materials Science and Engineering A.

Werner has been recipient/co-recipient of ten international scientific awards and received an honorary doctoral degree from the University of Salzburg in 2010.
